Club Legal Affairs and other Boring Matters

I think most of you know that I am an attorney, so I apologize in advance for taking up valuable newsletter space for "discussion of unlikely risks and other issues no one cares about."



In November of this past year, I discovered that the Club with the Georgia Secretary of State. We have been to the legal author (mostly) operating as a validly-organized entity for years, by holding annual meetings. had never been formally incorporated as a legal entity years, by holding annual meetings, monthly board meetings keeping financial corporate by-laws, but had missed this one detail of in-

corporation – probably because when the Club was formed with only enough people for one square, the risk was lower!

There are a hundred horrible things that could have happened as a result of the Club not actually existing as a legal organization (e.g., someone falls and hurts himself, our insurance company discovers that the Hotlanta Squares – the insured entity – does not exist, and then denies coverage, forcing the club to cash in its CDs and clean out its bank accounts to pay the injured member's hospital bills). We were very lucky, and neither this, nor any other worst-case scenario happened. Phew! The Club has now been incorporated with the Georgia Secretary of State as Hotlanta Squares, Inc.

To ensure our other legal obligations were in order, I also conducted a brief investigation and consulted with two CPAs. I have confirmed that the Club is registered as a 501(c)(4) organization with the IRS, which is the default status for "social welfare" groups, and the easiest status to maintain. It means that our donations to the Club are not tax-deductible, but it also means that as long as our revenue receipts are normally at \$50,000 or less each year, the Club only has to send in an e-filed postcard each year (Form 990N), instead of filing separate corporate tax returns or doing a number of other things. This, in turn, saves the Club from needing to hire (and pay) an accountant.

Going forward, the Club will be required to pay the annual registration fee to the Georgia Secretary of State (currently \$50/year). To remain in compliance under IRS rules, the Club will file a 990 with the IRS each year, and issue 1099-MISC forms to any person or company whom the Club pays \$600 or more per year.

What this means to the Club?

Future treasurers/event coordinators/fly-in chairs: Please note that the Club must collect W-9 forms for any callers or vendors to whom the Club will pay \$600 or more so that we can issue 1099s before January 31 of each year.

The board might want to buy a couple hours of a bookkeeper's time to help out with 1099 reporting in the winter.

The Club may want to consider recruiting a CPA to the board to do an informal audit of the Club's tax

Let me know if you have questions.


