

- You should never leave a square once you have joined it.
- You should never push your way into a space or force another square to move. Find an open area and start a new square there.
- You should let your fellow dancers hear all of Johnny's instructions. The buzz in the background makes it difficult to concentrate.
- There is no acceptable excuse for rough handling of fellow dancers! "Pull Thru" is a call not permission to injure.
- You should be sure to shower or bathe before attending. Be judicial in the application of aftershave, perfume and/or cologne. In close quarters, Less is More!





The GSSDA Convention - A Commentary by Larry M.

Yellow Rocks

A yellow rock is a hug directed to your corner. Used commonly to get the square to relax and get ready for the next call. Some callers will substitute different colors for different people in (or out of) the square. (Note: Ask Ed F. to tell you what the term yellow rocks *does not mean.*) Other generally accepted color codes for "hugees" are:

| Rock "Color" | Designated "Huggee" |

| Yellow Rock | Corner |
| Red Rock | Partner |
| Green Rock | Right-Hand Lady |
| Orange Rock | Opposite |
| Blue Rock | Caller |


